1. Call to Order by: Brooks at 6:02 PM.

2. Board of Directors Action to be Taken

- Approve February minutes: Ryan Scanlan motions to approve and Alicia 2nd. All approved.
- Approve financial reports:
 - Cory: \$32,547.97, expenses: LL Charter, utilities, Income: sponsorships and registration, next month expenses: equipment, fundraiser, approx. \$8,000 next month income: sponsorships, Ryan motioned to approved report, John
 - Laura: \$40,575, revenue \$16,238: signs, team sponsors, registration, expenses: \$1850: utilities, sponsorship to NV, mesh, ended month with: \$54,963 Rich motioned Scott 2nd, all in favor

3. President's Report

- Team Summary
 - 7 majors

4. Unfinished Business

 - Brooks opened up the floor for discussion
 - i. Ryan started the discussion
 - ii. Scott Flick wants to make a motion to go back to way it was, 2 innings 1 at bat. Discussion continued, Scott made a motion and 2nd by James. 14 in favor 5 not in favor, we will stick with continuous order.
- Minors update:
 - James shared all teams assigned, practice is going, equipment will be passed out Friday, 4 teams for coach pitch and teams and practice assigned. He feels everyone understands the field use
 - T-ball said teams are assigned.

 - Fundraising book organization: need help to organize the books
 - Fundraising nights: April 13th is Hofbrau, May 6th is Pelicans, and July 27th is The Field
 - Team parent reminder---March 15th at 1:00 at Spring Twp.

5. New Business

- Brad Kling asked about usage of the Bellefonte fields and why we can't use them.
 - His concern is the drive. He drives 30 minutes and doesn't want to keep driving. Explained to him that spring township will be available after games begin. Brooks explained how the schedule and fields will work.
- Majors Practices: Discussion about practice fields

- Concessions: Updated team manual, Paying umps with checks vs. cash out of concession
 - Free meal to players: possible sponsor for hot dogs for kids after games, trying to make it universal between all fields, hot dog and slushie/freeze pop
