### 1. Call to Order: Brooks at 6:01

### 2. Board of Directors Action to be Taken

- Approve March Minutes: Scott motioned and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Chris, all in favor, no opposed
  - Request to send notes in PDF version since Word doesn't always work.
- Approve Financial Reports:
  - Cory: as of today \$31, 829.13, previous \$32,540.97. Income for month \$6700.00, expenses \$7300.00. Projected expenses for next month: softball uniform and tournament, baseball equipment, and other misc. items.
    - Motion to approve his financial report by Chris, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Borger. All approved.
  - Laura: Total income: \$8,378.16, expenses: 19,426.86
    - Motion to approve Laura's. Larry motioned, Scott 2<sup>nd</sup>. All approved.
    - Cory asked for Laura to send her an invoice she will send it.
  - Full reports can be seen through any of the officers.

### 3. President's Report

- Website: Brooks has been working with Dana to get everything up and running on the website. Brooks feels it looks good. The site has a calendar link that can take you to all Game Changer links. Will automatically update. Dana will continue to update the site as needed.
- Gamechanger Leagues: Set up for majors and minors, can navigate to see records, etc. The team that starts the game first is the official book. Larry wants to make sure that the person starting first is the better person at keeping stats.
- Webster Field Tasks
  - Field Dirt: dirt was put on the field extra in shed
  - Edging- walk behind edger purchased
  - Signs: still some to put up
  - Rocks: encouraged to pick up rocks if seen on fields
  - Parking Lot Crack Sealing: looking for a vendor to seal cracks
  - Bathroom Cleaning: looking for services
- Puddle Sponges: bought 3 for each field, use them
- Concession Stand Ventilation and Electrical: PBCI Allen will install AC to circulate air in concession stand, will add a new outlet on own circuit

- Green Horizon completed first fertilizer application
- Portable Toilets- contacted by Dave Robinson, went with a different vendor. Robinson called him and Brooks shared the difference in cost, was frustrated with lack of communication, pumping during games, would like us to go back to them and would match Brandon's. Brooks asked if we want to stay with Brandon's or go back to Robinson's.
  - Cory suggests PG keep Robinson and Webster keeps Brandons. Stephanie motions to keep Brandons and James 2<sup>nd</sup>. All approved.
- Spring Township:
  - Sign to be put up, suggested to check with Bonchak to see if he wants signs.
    - Field dirt
    - Dugouts: Will be painted and have been power washed at no charge.
    - Shed: Brooks worked to collect donations to buy a shed to store supplies.

- Game Cancellation and Rescheduling Procedures
  - Weather Stations: Ryan has the weather stations, wants to make sure they are accurate.
  - Discussion was had as to what is the master schedule to follow: Game Changer or Sports Connect, Google sheet will be the master.
- Gamechanger Accuracy
- Time Limit for Majors: NV had a time limit and Bellefonte has not. Travis motioned to not start a new inning after 2 hours and if a double header then the 1<sup>st</sup> game is a hard 1 hour 45 minutes so 2<sup>nd</sup> game can get started, Borger 2<sup>nd</sup>, all in favor, not opposed.

- Lights Policy: Can use lights up to the time limit of games.
- Umpire Payments: All umpires will be given a check this year, Laura does Blf. Fields and Cory will do NV fields.
